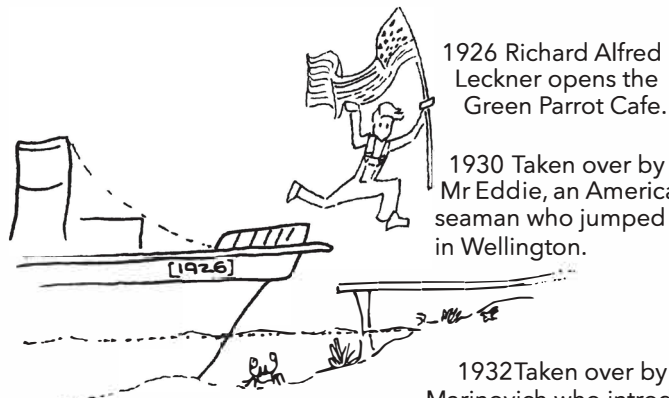

# THE GREEN PARROT CAFÉ HISTORY



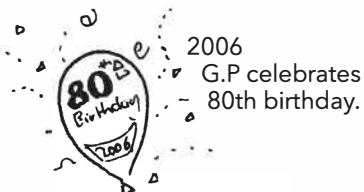
1926 Richard Alfred Leckner opens the Green Parrot Cafe.

2006 G.P celebrates 80th birthday.

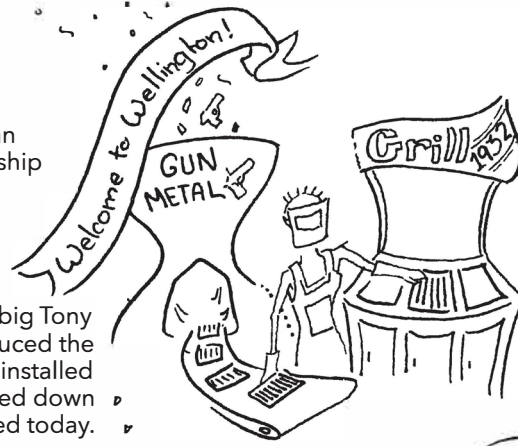


2000 G.P CLUB Welcomes the New Millennium with a party.

1999 Start of G.P CLUB.



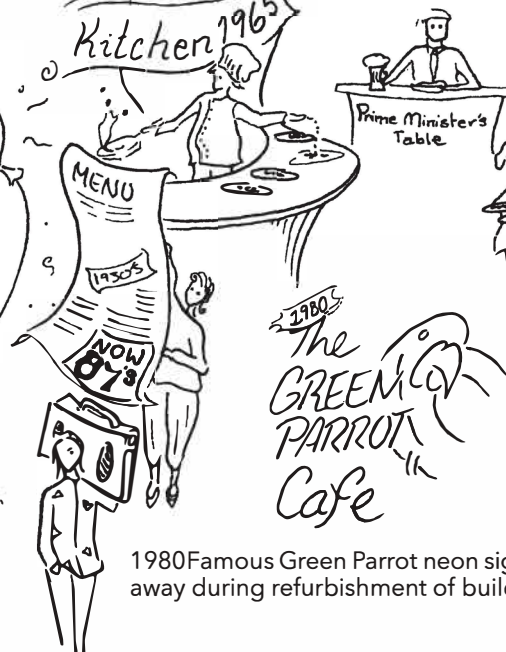
2003 Lord of the Rings Celebrity Party at the G.P.



1997 Top secret coalition meetings held at the G.P.

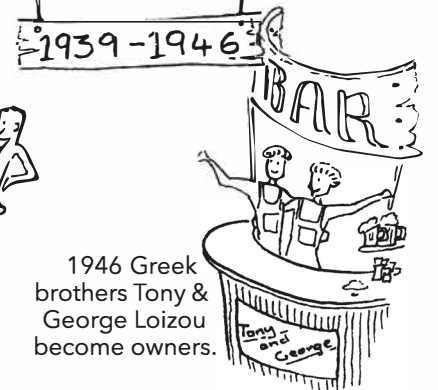


1996 70th birthday celebration attended by local sports and political dignitaries.
